



Subject:- Improving Capacity  
of Slow Learners

- \* During classroom lectures it has been observed that some of the students were less capable and slow learners due to the following reasons →
- (i) Poor concentration and less focus in classroom.
  - (ii) Poor handwriting as well as sketching.
  - (iii) Low attendance in classroom due to their remote location and general uninterest in studies.
  - (iv) Scoring poor grades in previous classes.
  - (v) Low attendance during departmental activities such as submission of charts, models etc.
- \* Following decisions have been taken for slow learners considering above problems
- (i) Selection of slow learners and co-ordinating them with other good students.
  - (ii) Providing study materials of locally available plants to understand the economic, taxonomic and ecological value.
  - (iii) Allotment of simple and easy assignments in concerned papers and promoting them to prepare power point presentation. i.e.

- by utilizing smart class facility.
- (iv) Constituting a departmental council for various competitions like poster, essay writing, extempore, speech, quiz etc and motivating slow learners for active participation.
  - (v) Slow learners will be provided easy accessibility in departmental library for study material & quality books.

# Report of Slow and Advanced Learners of B.Ed. Department

B.Ed. is a Training Programme and Admission process done through Entrance Examination conducted by affiliating University. The following activities conducted for the betterment and advancement of the slow and advanced learners.

Drama in Education should not be merely doing theatrics or 'acting' in a superficial manner, but should perform for creating the 'dramatic pressure' or tension, where the student would arrive at a problem or an understanding in a new way. Drama as 'critical pedagogy' should move beyond the classroom, to invoke the collective consciousness and involve the community to participate in educational and social change.

Experiencing different kinds of street theatre that engage with life, through folk and contemporary traditions, improvising and critiquing, while mobilising for

transformative action based on experience, emotion and interpretation. It should help in understanding the self and as a form of self-expression for enhancing creativity.

Visit to places of art, exhibitions and cultural festivals. Encouragement needs to be given to understand local culture and art forms and interpret art works, movies and other Media. Experiences on expanding perceiving art world, their artistic processes, sense of understanding and ways of assessing the work. Activities can be used to build trust and cooperation, the sense of responsibility, pursuing tasks collectively and exploring varied perspectives.

**Following activities are organized by the department :**

- a) Visit to the places of local culture and art and prepare report
- b) Write a report on creativity among the students
- c) Watch movies or other media of educational significance and prepare report
- d) Write a Script /dialogue
- e) Organise a Drama for educational purpose
- f) Report of cultural festivals
- g) Organization of fete in the institution and prepare report
- h) Evaluation of report

**(C) Critical Understanding of ICT :**

Organizing activities to explore ICTs in teaching-learning, administrative and academic support systems and broader implications for society. Off-line and on-line learning, E-learning -use and importance of chat, E-mail, E-library, discussion forum, e-journals, e-reading and blogs.

ICT in education: Meaning, scope, advantages and limitations. Using search engines. Role of information technology in 'construction of knowledge'. Use of ICTs to simplify record keeping, information management in education administration.

Web sites; Meaning of technology mediated learning. Concept and scope of E-content authoring. Role of Edusat – Gyan Darsan. Teleconferencing- audio, video and computer mediated- Skype. Role of the teacher in technology mediated learning. New concepts of technology in educational process.

**Following activities are organized by the department :**

- a) Preparation and presentation of ppt.
- b) Prepare and Submit an E-assignment.
- c) Create a group in a social network of the class.
- d) Create a web page of personal profile.
- e) Download Educational resources and prepare a report.

#### **(D) Understanding the Self**

Conduction of a workshop by more than one resource person to develop understanding of student teachers about themselves. The development of the self as a person and as a teacher, through conscious ongoing reflection. The development of the inner self and the professional identity of a teacher and social relational sensitivity and effective communication skills, including the ability to listen and observe. To develop a holistic and integrated understanding of the human self and personality; to build resilience within to deal with conflicts at different levels and learn to create teams to draw upon collective strengths.

Use of personal narratives, life stories, group interactions, film reviews to help explore one's dreams, aspirations, concerns, through varied forms of self-expression, including poetry and humour, creative movement, aesthetic representations, etc.

Yoga will also be introduced as an important component to enhance abilities of body and mind and promote sensibilities that help to live in peace and harmony with one's surroundings. Students will appreciate the philosophy of yoga and its role in well-being. They will learn the practice of yoga and how to use it in different contexts.

Recollect and share your childhood experiences with the peer group.

The following methodologies for the transaction of the course could be used in interactive sessions:

Sharing case studies/biographies/stories of different children who are raised in different circumstances and how this affected their sense of self and identity formation.

Watching a movie/documentary where the protagonist undergoes trials and finally discovers her/his potential despite odds.

Issues of contemporary adolescence/youth need to be taken up as student-teachers first need to understand themselves in relation to their students and classroom situations.

Different modes of expression can be used in each of the sessions (so that each of the students get a chance to express him/herself through any of the modes that they are comfortable in) and at the end of the year, the resource person and the coordinating faculty can reflect back on whether all modes of expression were included in the sessions or not.

#### **Following activities are organized by the department-**

- a) Developing reflective journals/workshop report/prepare a Yoga file.
- b) Compose a short story and reflect yourself through a puppet.
