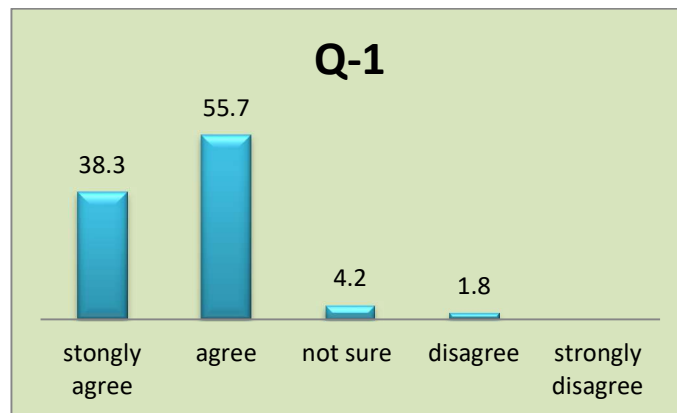

SUMMARY

The feedback analysis process has put an increasing emphasis on the need for involvement of faculty in the quality assurance of excellent education. Faculty involvement requires that they play an active role in participating for the development of students. In the year 2018-19, 76 faculty members gave their feedback. Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The college collects the feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses. Overall 12 questions were designed to obtain the responses of the faculty members. The questions comprise almost the entire aspect of the institution with which faculty members may associate themselves with the affecting factors (Directly or indirectly).

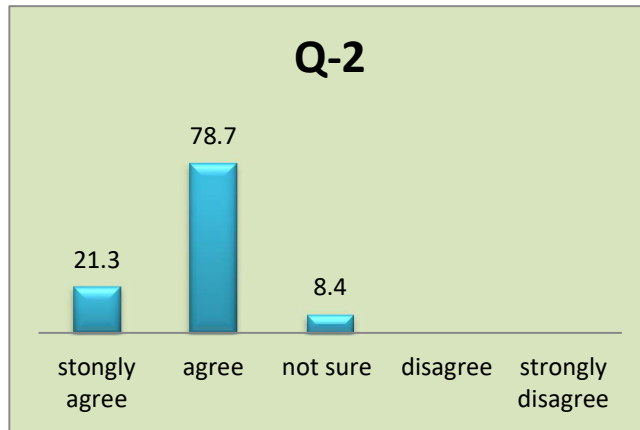
ANALYSIS OF DATA

Q1- College Vision, philosophy & objectives are in tune with Govt. Policies and reflected in college decisions.



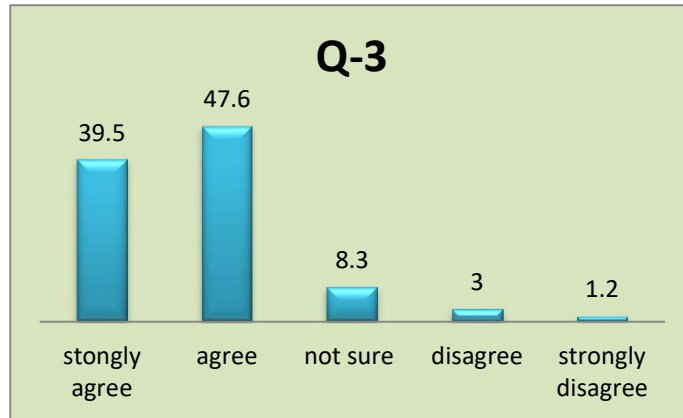

Q2- Students are disciplined and respect the faculty and staff members.



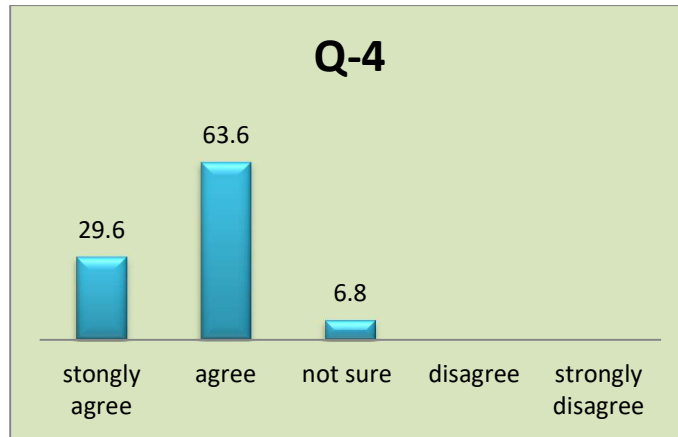
According to above data overall 92% of all faculty members are satisfied from college discipline and agreed that students are disciplined and respect the faculty and staff members.

Q3- College provides opportunities for continuous academic development of Staff.



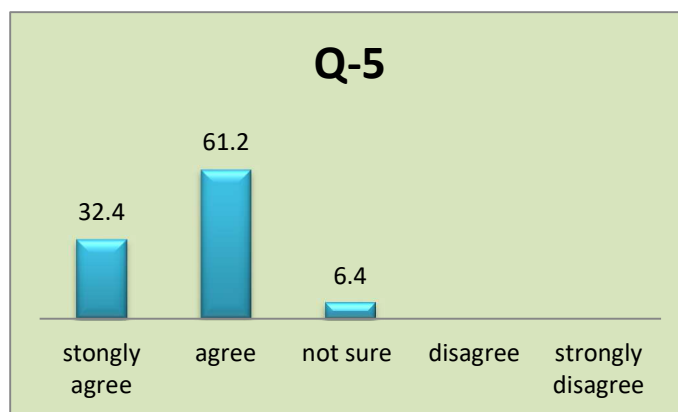
College provides all possible facilities for continuous academic development of staff, about 88% of all faculty members are agreed with the above statement. Rest of staff may be not aware of this opportunity.

Q4- The curriculum is outcome based and the expected outcomes through various course, are attained.



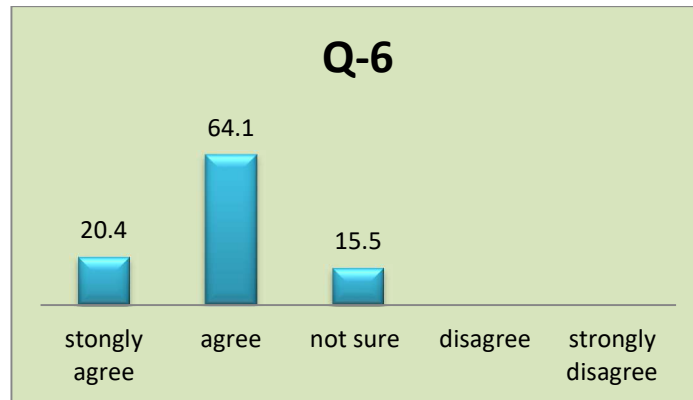
As shown in above graph about 30% of faculty members are strongly agreed and about 64% are agreed that curriculum is outcome based and the expected outcomes through various courses are attained.

Q5- Equal opportunity for all staff is provided.



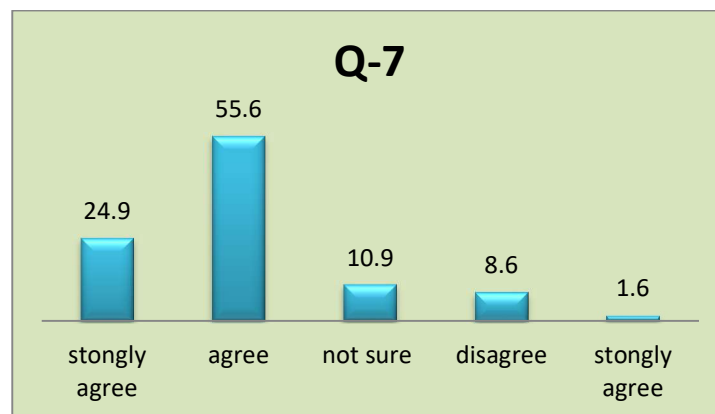
From the above graphical presentation, it is clear that about 94% of all faculty members are agreed that college provided equal opportunity for all staff.

Q6- Laboratory requirements including Equipment's, Chemicals and Specimens are regularly provided by the college. (if applicable)



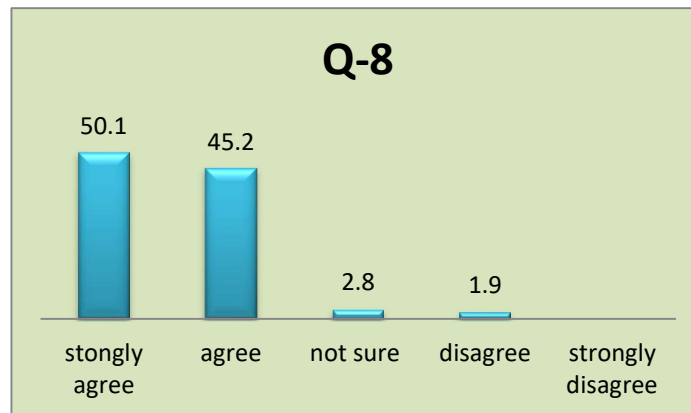

Q7- Computer facilities are made available for ICT based teaching to the teachers.



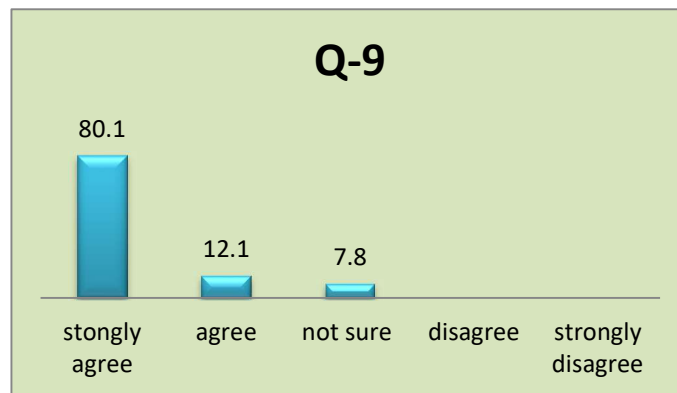

Q8- College pays attention to conservation of environment.



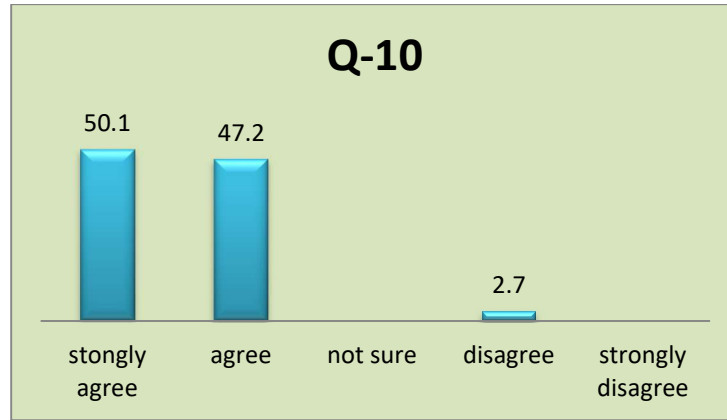

Q9- Principal/Head of Department is approachable and accessible.



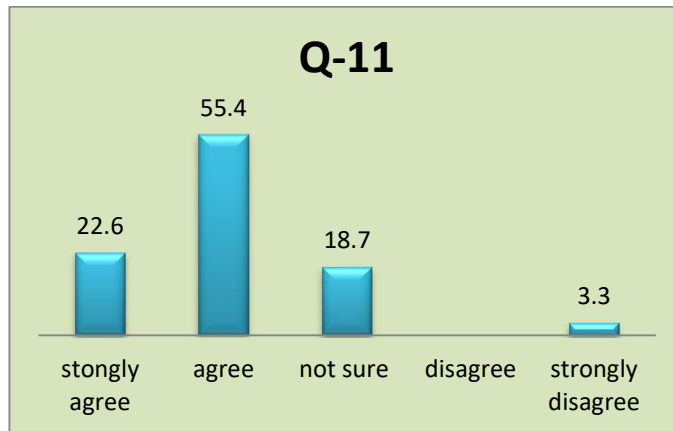

Q10- Data, documents, records and evidences are well maintained at our Department & Other places.



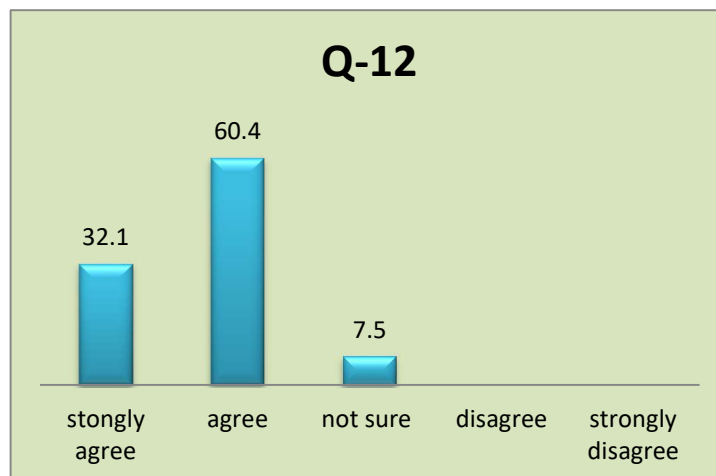
According to the above graphical representation it is clear that most of the faculty members are agreed that the data, documents, records and evidences are well maintained at our Department & Other places.

SUGGESTIONS

- Steps should be taken to motivate students to follow rules and requiring of the college.
- The laboratories of the college need improvement and some equipment need repairs.
- To promote ICT based teaching, more classrooms with projection, Introduce Board and other related equipment.
- Some of the toilets, staff room and classrooms need renovation and some of these needs minor repair. Dedicated toilets for differently able is needed.
- The curriculum enrichment scheduled for the college requires inclusion of some left over department.
- College should also promote the activities for the academic advancement of the faculty by organizing various workshops, training program and other academic pursuits for equal opportunity of all staff.

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
